Four Agencies Join AARP for Magnolia Town Hall Meeting

LITTLE ROCK, ARKANSAS (May 4, 2010) —Four state agencies are partnering this year with the AARP to hold a town hall-style meeting in Magnolia on Monday, May 10, 2010, at the Donald W. Reynolds Campus and Community Center at Southern Arkansas University. The Arkansas Insurance Department joins the Office of the Attorney General, the Department of Human Services Division of Aging and Adult Services, and the Arkansas Securities Department to present this meeting for seniors which will focus on fraud in insurance, securities, and Medicare as well as provide general discussion on senior issues. Joining these state agencies and AARP will be Raymon B. Harvey, an attorney specializing in elder law and special needs trusts.
