## NOTICE OF HEARING

You are hereby notified that an administrative hearing has been scheduled pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 23-61-303 and other applicable provisions of Arkansas law, before Insurance Commissioner Allen Kerr, as Hearing Officer, or his designee, on July 19, 2016, at 9:00 a.m. in the First Floor Hearing Room, Arkansas Insurance Department ("Department"), 1200 West Third Street, Little Rock, Arkansas. The Respondent, Robert Dupree, has the right to be represented by legal counsel of your own choosing at this proceeding. Additionally, the Commissioner will obtain a competent reporter to record the hearing. You may avail yourself of other privileges, including the Department's assistance to subpoena any needed witnesses or records. The purpose of this hearing is to allow you to appeal the Department's suspension of your Resident Producer License, AID No 2016-57, and to hear the allegations described below. The allegations against you include:

1) Respondent is three months or more in arrears in child support payment as determined by the Arkansas Office of Child Support Enforcement, a violation of Ark. Code Ann. § 23-64-512(a)(14).

2) Respondent provided incorrect or misleading information on his producer application and his 2016 producer renewal application, a violation of Ark. Code

Ann. § 23-64-512(a)(1). Specifically, on his March 24, 2014, producer application, Respondent denied ever having an insurance license or any previous administrative actions. Respondent was previously licensed as an insurance producer and his producer license was revoked in 2011 as per AID No. 2011-19.

Each of these issues shall be presented at your hearing, but the Department is not limited to only these allegations may our investigations uncover further wrongdoing.

Your verbal or written notification that you have received this notice of hearing must be received in this office within ten (10) days of your receipt. If your notification is not received by the Department within ten (10) days, any and all expenses incurred by the Department in continuing the hearing or in notification of witnesses, including but not limited to, phone calls, issuance of subpoenas and postage, will be charged to the party or parties requesting such continuance. If you or your attorney determines that a continuance or an earlier hearing is necessary, or you have questions or concerns, please contact me at (501) 371-2829.
