NOTICE OF HEARING

Dear Ms. Tidwell:

You are hereby notified that an administrative hearing has been scheduled pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. §§ 23-61-303 and other applicable provisions of Arkansas law, before Insurance Commissioner Allen Kerr, as Hearing Officer, or his designee, on October 22, 2015, at 1:30 p.m. in the First Floor Hearing Room, Arkansas Insurance Department ("Department"), 1200 West Third Street, Little Rock, Arkansas.

You have the right to represent yourself or be represented by legal counsel of your own choosing at this proceeding. Additionally, the Commissioner will obtain a competent reporter to record the hearing. You may avail yourself of other privileges, including the Department's assistance to subpoena any needed witnesses or records.

The allegations against you are:

- 1) Using fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness, lack of good personal or business reputation, or financial irresponsibility as defined by Ark. Code Ann. § 23-64-512(a)(8).
- 2) Failing to cooperate with the commissioner in an investigation when required by the commissioner as required by Ark. Code Ann. § 23-64-512(a)(17).
- 3) Improperly withholding money or property received in the course of doing insurance business as defined by Ark. Code Ann. § 23-64-512(a)(4).
- 4) Failure to inform the Arkansas Insurance Department of filing a bankruptcy within thirty days as required by Ark. Code Ann. § 23-64-201(e).
- 5) Proving inaccurate or misleading information on insurance renewal as defined by Ark. Code Ann. § 23-64-512(a)(1). Specifically, you failed to accurately answer that you had filed bankruptcy.

Each of these issues shall be presented at your hearing, but the Department is not limited to only these allegations may our investigations uncover further wrongdoing.

Your verbal or written notification that you have received this notice of hearing must be received in this office within ten (10) days of your receipt. If your notification is not received by the Department within ten (10) days, any and all expenses incurred by the Department in continuing the hearing or in notification of witnesses, including but not limited to, phone calls, issuance of subpoenas and postage, will be charged to the party or parties requesting such continuance. If you or your attorney determines that a continuance is necessary, or you have questions or concerns, please contact me at (501) 371-2829.
