**ORDER OF CANCELLATION**

Now on this day the matter of the Arkansas Certificate of Authority (Certificate of Registration) No. 762 of Realm National Insurance Company, NAIC #15466 ("Company" or "RRG"), a New York-domiciled insurer, is taken under consideration by Julie Benafield Bowman, Insurance Commissioner for the State of Arkansas ("Commissioner"), as presented by Ms. Jean Langford, Chief Counsel, Legal Division of the Arkansas Insurance Department ("Department"). From the facts, matters and other things before the Commissioner, she finds as follows:

1. That the Commissioner has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter involved herein.
2. That the Company is a New York-domiciled insurer formerly authorized to transact insurance in the State of Arkansas under its Arkansas certificate of authority.
3. That the Company is in liquidation in the domiciliary state of New York, is not conducting business in Arkansas pursuant to the receivership, and has no Arkansas claims according to the Liquidation Division of the New York Insurance Department.
4. That on this date the Commissioner has determined that the causes as stated make it appropriate and expedient to revoke, cancel or expire the Company's Arkansas Certificate of Authority. The Company is now in liquidation; and through its representative, the New York Liquidation Bureau, states due to that liquidation proceeding, there is no need to continue the Company's Arkansas Certificate of Authority; and that New York has no objection to revocation or cancellation of that subsisting Certificate of Authority.

5. That the Commissioner hereby orders an immediate revocation, cancellation and expiration of the Company's Arkansas Certificate No. 762, pursuant to his authority under Ark. Code Ann. §23-63-212, 213 and 215. The Company shall file its final Year 2005 Annual Statement, or liquidating statement in lieu thereof if permitted by the Finance Division of this Department. The Company shall report and pay all fees and taxes and premium taxes required under Arkansas laws for the final 2005 year of withdrawal in Arkansas.

6. That the Company is ordered to return for cancellation its original, wet-signed Arkansas Certificate of Authority (Certificate of Registration) No. 762, which this Department will physically cancel to reflect the revocation/cancellation provisions of this Order. The Department shall revoke and cancel the original, and the duplicate original, Certificates of Authority on file at this Office.

7. That upon the effective date of this Order, the original and duplicate Certificates of Authority for the Company shall be considered null and void; and shall have no further legal effect.

8. That the appointed agents and producers for this Company listed on Department records shall be sent a notice about this Order.
