CONSENT ORDER

On this day, Julie Benafield Bowman, Arkansas Insurance Commissioner ("Commissioner"), and Keith Aaron Cribb ("Respondent") agree to enter into this Consent Order for the reasons stated below. From the facts and law before the Commissioner, she finds:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the parties and subject matter pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 23-61-103.
2. Respondent applied with the Arkansas Insurance Department ("Department") to be licensed as an agent under the property and casualty lines of authority. On his application he revealed that in 2005, he was convicted of Battery in the Third Degree and sentenced to a six months suspended sentence with seven days community service following an altercation with his ex-wife on the night of his twenty-first birthday party.
3. Based on the above, the Department declined Respondent's request for a license. Respondent requested a hearing.
4. Respondent has provided information that he is remarried, as well as a father and caregiver of twin infants. He currently assists his father, Karl Cribb, in his father's insurance practice. Moreover, Respondent has been shown to be an upstanding member of the community.

Therefore, the Arkansas Insurance Commissioner finds that:

5. Respondent's request for a producer's license is approved so long as the following conditions are met:
 - a. Respondent agrees to a probationary period of one (1) year to be supervised by his father, Karl Cribb, during this period;

b. Quarterly reports will be submitted to the Department over the course of the one (1) year period detailing Respondent's progress;

c. The first quarterly report will be due by the 30th day of the month following Respondent's licensure as an insurance agent in Arkansas; and

d. Failure to meet these requirements or violation of another law will result in the immediate suspension of Respondent's license and a hearing before the Commissioner.
