**ADOPTION ORDER**

Now on this day the matter of the Report of Examination ("Report") as of December 31, 2005, of HMO Partners, Inc. ("HMO"), of Little Rock, Arkansas, NAIC #95442, is taken under consideration by Julie Benafield Bowman, Insurance Commissioner for the State of Arkansas ("Commissioner"), as presented by its Associate Counsel, Amanda Capps Rose, and the Finance Division of the Arkansas Insurance Department ("Department"). From the facts, matters and other things before her, the Commissioner finds as follows:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. That the Commissioner has jurisdiction over the HMO and the subject matter involved herein.
2. That the HMO is an Arkansas-domiciled health maintenance organization.
3. That pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 23-76-122, the Commissioner authorized and directed the Department to conduct a regular examination of the affairs, transactions, accounts, records, and assets of the HMO as of December 31, 2005.
4. That said examination was commenced by the Department on October 20, 2006 and completed on January 3, 2007.
5. That the verified Report of Examination was filed with the Department on February 2, 2007; it was then forwarded to the HMO via certified mail on February 2,

2007. The HMO received the Report on February 8, 2007, according to the certified mail return receipt returned to the Department.

6. That the Report of Examination contains no comments on discrepancies or deficiencies concerning the HMO's operations. The HMO acknowledged receipt of the Report in correspondence dated March 9, 2007 and did not submit any comments or rebuttal.

THEREFORE, pursuant to the provisions of Ark. Code Ann. §§ 23-76-104(2) and 23-61-205, the Commissioner hereby orders:

1. That the Examination Report, as filed with the Department, is hereby adopted;

2. That the Department shall forward a copy of this Order and the adopted Examination Report, as filed, to the HMO via certified mail. The mailing to the HMO shall include specimen affidavit forms for the HMO's Directors to use in acknowledgement of receipt of the adopted Report of Examination and this Order;

3. That within twenty (20) days of receipt of this Order and the adopted Examination Report, the HMO shall file with the Department affidavits executed by each one of its Directors, stating under oath or affirmation that each has received a copy of this Order and the adopted Examination Report;

4. That the adopted Examination Report shall be open for public inspection upon the expiration of thirty (30) days from the HMO's receipt of this Order.
