CONSENT REVOCATION ORDER

On this day, Julie Benafield Bowman, Arkansas Insurance Commissioner ("Commissioner"), and Trisha Eileen Trahan ("Respondent") agree to enter into this Consent Revocation Order for the reasons stated below. The Respondent neither admits nor denies any of the Findings of Fact or the Conclusions of Law below. From the facts and law before the Commissioner, she finds:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the parties and subject matter pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 23-61-103.
2. Respondent was licensed as a resident life, accident and health, casualty, marine, property, and surety producer in February, 2006, after failing to advise the Arkansas Insurance Department ("Department") that she had a prior felony conviction. Her Arkansas resident producer license number is 294992.
3. On May 17, 2006, the Arkansas Insurance Department ("Department") was advised of the prior felony conviction by Respondent's employer, Casey Starkey, and informed of the investigation against Respondent for several other criminal acts.
4. On October 26, 2006, Bob Buschbacher of the Baxter County Sherriff's Office Criminal Investigative Division faxed information to the Department stating that Respondent was arrested by the Baxter County Sherriff's Department on April 25, 2006 for Theft of Property, Fraudulent Use of a Credit Card, and Harassing Communications. The facsimile also stated that Respondent was arrested on May 2, 2006 and charged with Theft of Property. Theft of

Property and Fraudulent Use of a Credit Card are both Class C felonies. Harassing Communications is a Class A misdemeanor. The facsimile also related that Respondent had a prior record of Aggravated Assault and Vandalism in Shelby County, Tennessee, with a disposition date of March 12, 2004.

5. Respondent did not notify the Department within ten (10) days of her arrests and the subsequent charges being filed.

6. On November 6, 2006, the Baxter County Circuit Clerk sent Docket Sheet sent the Department a copy of the Criminal Docket sheets related to the arrests on April 25, 2006, and May 2, 2006.

7. On November 16, 2006, Respondent pled guilty to two counts of Theft of Property, Fraudulent Use of a Credit Card, and Harassing Communications and was sentenced to three (3) years probation and court costs.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

8. For the above actions, Respondent is in violation of Ark. Code Ann. §§ 23-64-201 (h), 23-64-512(a)(1), (2), (3), (6), and (8).

9. Considering the Commissioner's Conclusions of Law, the Respondent voluntarily surrenders her producer license for revocation by the Department.


THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED AND AGREED that:
