CONSENT REVOCATION ORDER

On this day, Julie Benafield Bowman, Arkansas Insurance Commissioner (“Commissioner”), and Patricia Ann Harris (“Respondent”) agree to enter into this Consent Revocation Order for the reasons stated below. Respondent neither admits nor denies any of the Findings of Fact or the Conclusions of Law contained herein. From the facts and law before the Commissioner, she finds and concludes as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the parties and subject matter pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 23-61-103 and other provisions of the Arkansas Insurance Code.
2. Respondent was licensed as a non-resident property and casualty producer in August 2006. Respondent’s non-resident producer license number is 302438.
3. The records of the Arkansas Insurance Department (“Department”) reflect that the Respondent has used multiple Social Security numbers.
4. This Department made several attempts to contact the Respondent regarding her use of multiple social security numbers. On April 6, Joie Tester of the Legal Division had a telephone conference with the Respondent during which the Respondent stated that a written explanation would be received by the Department no later than April 9, 2007. However, no written explanation was received. Subsequent phone calls from this Department were not returned.

5. On April 23, 2007, this Department provided notice to the Respondent via certified mail that an Investigative Conference would be held on May 4, 2007 to discuss this matter. Respondent failed to appear or respond in any way to the April 23, 2007 notice.

6. After several telephone conversations between this Department's Legal Division and the Respondent subsequent to May 4, 2007, the Department received written correspondence from the Respondent dated October 15, 2007. The correspondence stated that the Respondent plans to retire and requests that her license be deactivated. The October 15, 2007 correspondence is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW


7. Respondent's failure to submit a written response when requested and her failure to appear at the May 4, 2007 Investigative Conference are violations of Ark. Code Ann. § 23-64-512(a)(13) and Ark. Code Ann. § 23-64-512(a)(17), respectively.

8. After considering the Commissioner's Conclusions of Law, the Respondent voluntarily surrenders her non-resident producer license for revocation by the Department.

THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED AND AGREED that:

9. All licenses issued by the Department to Patricia Ann Harris are hereby revoked.


