ORDER

Now on this day the matter of the Report of Examination of DELTA DENTAL PLAN OF ARKANSAS, INC., NAIC#47155, (hereafter, the "Company") is taken under consideration by Jay Bradford, Insurance Commissioner for the State of Arkansas, (the "Commissioner"), with the Arkansas Insurance Department (the "Department") appearing by and through Robert Alexander, Associate Counsel. From the facts before him, the Commissioner finds as follows:


1. The Company is licensed by the Department to operate in this state as a hospital medical service corporation under Ark. Code Ann. §23-75-101 et seq.
2. Pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. §23-75-114, the Commissioner directed the Department to conduct a regular examination of the affairs, transactions, accounts, and assets of the Company as of December 31, 2007.
3. The examination began on August 1, 2008 and was completed on March 6, 2009. A verified report of examination (the "Report") was filed at the Department on April 10, 2009 and was mailed to the Company on April 13, 2009. The Company received the Report on April 14, 2009, and the Company did not submit a written reply or rebuttal in response to the Report.

4. On April 29, 2009, the Company informed the Department that it would not reply to the report and that it waived any remaining days in which to reply to the Report.
5. The Report contained no discrepancies concerning the Company's operations.

THEREFORE, pursuant to the provisions of Ark. Code Ann. §23-61-205, et seq., the Commissioner hereby orders:

1. That the Report filed with the Department is hereby adopted;
2. That the Department shall forward a copy of this Order and the Adopted Examination Report to the Company via certified mail;
3. That within twenty (20) days of receipt of this Order and the Adopted Examination Report, the Company shall file with the Department affidavits executed by each of its directors stating under oath that they have received a copy of this Order and the Adopted Examination Report.
4. That the Adopted Examination Report will be open for public inspection upon the expiration of thirty (30) days from the Company's receipt of this Order.
