ADOPTION ORDER

Now on this day the matter of the Report of Examination ("Report" or "Report of Examination") as of December 31, 2008, of Jackson Griffin Insurance Company ("Company"), NAIC No. 84115, is taken under consideration by Jay Bradford, Insurance Commissioner for the State of Arkansas ("Commissioner"), as presented by Associate Counsel, Nina Samuel Carter, and the Finance Division of the Arkansas Insurance Department ("Department"). From the facts, matters and other things before him, the Commissioner finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. That the Commissioner has jurisdiction over the Company and the subject matter involved herein.
2. That the Company is an Arkansas domiciled insurer authorized to transact the business of assessment life and disability insurance and is in good standing. The Company also markets life and annuity contracts to fund funeral expense contracts.
3. Pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. §§ 23-61-201, et seq., the Commissioner authorized and directed the Department to conduct a regular examination of the affairs, transactions, accounts, records and assets of the Company as of December 31, 2008.

4. That the examination was commenced by the Department Examiners on July 8, 2009, at the Company home office located at 1900 Malcolm Avenue, Newport, Arkansas 72112, and was completed on August 14, 2009.

5. That the verified Report of Examination ("Report") was filed with the Department on October 2, 2009; it was then forwarded to the Company via certified mail on October 5, 2009. The Report was received by the Company on October 6, 2009, as evidenced by the certified mail receipt. The Company made no response or rebuttal to the Report.

6. The Report is confined to comments on matters involving departures from laws, rules, bulletins or matters deemed to require explanation or description.


7. The Report notes that the Company was in violation of Ark. Code Ann. § 23-64-219(b) for not maintaining the continuation of the agent's appointment. It is recommended that the Company implement a procedure that will ensure continuation of the agent's appointment and maintain compliance with Ark. Code Ann. § 23-64-219(b).

THEREFORE, pursuant to the provisions of Ark. Code Ann. § 23-61-205, the Commissioner hereby orders:

1. That the Examination Report as filed with the Department is hereby adopted;
2. That the Department shall forward a copy of this Order and the adopted Examination Report to the Company via certified mail;
3. That within twenty (20) days of its receipt of this Order and the adopted Examination Report, the Company shall file with the Department affidavits executed by each of its Directors, stating under oath or affirmation that each has received a copy of this Order and the adopted Examination Report; and

4. That the adopted Examination Report will be open for public inspection upon the expiration of thirty (30) days from the Company's receipt of this Order.
