CONSENT ORDER

On this day, the matter of Christi Lynn Haught (“Respondent”) came before Jay Bradford, Arkansas Insurance Commissioner (“Commissioner”). The Arkansas Insurance Department (“Department”) is represented by Amanda Capps Rose, Associate Counsel, in this matter. Respondent neither admits nor denies the findings and conclusions contained herein. From the facts and law before the Commissioner, he finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 23-61-103.
2. Respondent is licensed to write life, accident, health and sickness, property, casualty and surety insurance and holds Arkansas Resident Producer License No. 59602.
3. Respondent is a resident of Alma, Arkansas and at the time of the matters discussed herein, she was the Associate Agent for DC Capital Insurance Services, Inc. in Alma, Arkansas.
4. Premium in the amount of twelve thousand, five hundred ninety-one dollars (\$12,591.00) was paid to the Respondent on a policy issued to Fifth Dimension, LLC, the insured.
5. Due to a clerical oversight on the part of an employee, the premium was not remitted to the insurer, which caused the insurer to issue a cancellation notice on or about July 30, 2009.

6. The insured's policy has been reinstated without a lapse in coverage. Additionally, the Respondent has made full restitution of the premium funds.

7. During the course of the Department's investigation, the Respondent cooperated and provided a sworn statement regarding the matter.

8. Respondent took full responsibility for the failure of her agency to remit the premium payment to the insurer as it should have.


CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

From the Findings of Fact contained herein, the Commissioner concludes as follows:

9. Pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 23-64-512(a)(8), the demonstration of financial irresponsibility is grounds for placing an insurance producer's license on probation.

10. Based upon the foregoing, the Commissioner concludes that the Respondent's Arkansas Resident Producer License No. 59602 should be and hereby is immediately placed in probationary status for a period of eighteen (18) months.
