



quoted the Respondent as stating that he falsified information on insurance policies since 2008 or 2009 and "knew it was wrong to do this." The Respondent has since disputed the allegation that he falsified information on insurance policies.

5. Respondent has consulted legal counsel and has agreed to waive his right to an administrative hearing and voluntarily surrender his Arkansas Nonresident Producer License.

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

From the Findings of Fact contained herein, the Commissioner concludes as follows:

1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 23-61-103.


2. The commission of any insurance unfair trade practice or fraud is grounds for license revocation pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 23-64-512(a)(7).


3. That sufficient grounds exist for license revocation pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 23-64-512(a)(8).

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

In consideration of the Commissioner's Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the surrender of Respondent's Arkansas Nonresident Producer License No. 359605 is hereby accepted and immediately revoked.
