CONSENT ORDER

On this day, the matter of Jason C. South (“Respondent”) came before Jay Bradford, Arkansas Insurance Commissioner (“Commissioner”). The Arkansas Insurance Department (“Department”) is represented by Amanda Capps Rose, Associate Counsel, in this matter. From the facts and law before him, the Commissioner finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent holds Arkansas Nonresident Producer License No. 367221, which was suspended by A.I.D. Order No. 2011-236.
2. Respondent’s Arkansas Nonresident Producer License No. 367221 was suspended solely on the basis of the inactive status of his resident producer license in his previous state of domicile. Respondent now holds an active producer license in his home state of Connecticut.
3. Respondent has knowingly and voluntarily waived his right to legal counsel and an administrative hearing and voluntarily desires to surrender his Arkansas Nonresident Producer License.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

From the Findings of Fact contained herein, the Commissioner concludes as follows:


1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 23-61-103.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


1. In consideration of the Commissioner's Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Respondent's Arkansas Nonresident Producer License No. 376221 is hereby voluntarily surrendered by the Respondent.

2. The Suspension Order previously entered in this matter, A.I.D. Order No. 2011-236 is hereby rescinded and replaced by this Consent Order.
