ORDER

On this day, the matter of Melody Ann Bannach (“Respondent”) came before Jay Bradford, Arkansas Insurance Commissioner (“Commissioner”). The Arkansas Insurance Department (“Department”) was represented by Amanda Capps Rose, Associate Counsel, in this matter. From the facts and law before the Commissioner, he finds and concludes as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent holds Arkansas Nonresident Producer License Number 337924, which was suspended by A.I.D. Order No. 2012-449 due to the inactive status of the Respondent’s home state resident producer license.
2. Respondent has provided evidence that, prior to the suspension of her license, she submitted a written request to voluntarily surrender her license to the License Division of the Department.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW


From the Findings of Fact contained herein, the Commissioner concludes as follows:

3. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 23-61-103.
4. Respondent has the right to voluntarily surrender her Arkansas Nonresident Producer License.

IT IS THEREFORE AGREED AND ORDERED:

In consideration of the above findings and conclusions, it is agreed that Respondent's Arkansas Nonresident Producer License Number 337924 is voluntarily surrendered and will be placed in inactive status. This order rescinds and replaces A.I.D. Order No. 2012-449.
