CONSENT ORDER

On this day, Jay Bradford, Arkansas Insurance Commissioner ("Commissioner") and Lashauna A. Purifie ("Respondent") agree to enter into this Consent Order for the reasons stated below. From the facts and law before the Commissioner, he finds:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the parties and subject matter pursuant to Arkansas Code Annotated § 23-61-103.
2. On April 10, 2012, Respondent submitted to the Arkansas Insurance Department an application for licensure as a Non-resident Producer. A question on the application required Respondent to state whether she had ever been convicted of a crime, and Respondent answered "no."
3. Pursuant to Arkansas Code Annotated § 23-64-508(a), the Commissioner granted Respondent a Non-resident Producer License, #400065, based upon the Respondent's resident license in the state of Arizona.
4. The Respondent provided notice and documentation of a criminal conviction in 2000 that was not disclosed on the original application for Non-resident Producer License in Arkansas.

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CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

5. Respondent's criminal conviction is a violation of Arkansas Code Annotated § 23-64-512(a)(8), and Respondent's failure to provide correct information on Respondent's Non-resident Producer License application is a violation of Arkansas Code Annotated §§ 23-64-512(a)(1) and (3).

THE PARTIES HAVE AGREED THAT:


A. Respondent will be placed on Probation for one (1) full year of licensure from the date of this order.


B. Respondent understands that Respondent's conviction information will be open to the public pursuant to the Arkansas Freedom of Information Act of 1967, Arkansas Code Annotated §§ 25-19-101, *et. seq.*

C. Respondent understands that this Consent Order will be provided to the National Association of Insurance Commissioner and will be accessible by other states.

D. Respondent understands that this Consent Order may be used any future administrative proceedings brought against Respondent by the Commissioner.
