CONSENT ORDER

On this day, the matter of Mark Vaughan (“Respondent”), came before Jay Bradford, Arkansas Insurance Commissioner (“Commissioner”). The Arkansas Insurance Department (“Department”) is represented by Ava Franks, Associate Counsel, in this matter. From the facts and law before the Commissioner, he finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter pursuant to Arkansas Code Annotated § 23-61-103.
2. Respondent is a resident of Colorado and holds Arkansas Non-Resident Producer License No. 306347.
3. On or about March 7, 2013, Respondent pled guilty to the following crimes in Denver County, Colorado: 1) criminal attempt to commit sexual assault in violation of the Colorado Revised Statute Sections 18-3-402(1)(b), 18-2-101, a felony; and 2) child abuse in violation of Colorado Revised Statute Sections 18-6-401(1)(a), (7)(a)(V), a misdemeanor.

4. Respondent disclosed the aforementioned matter to the Department April 24, 2013. Respondent failed to disclose the aforementioned convictions to the Department in a timely manner.

5. Respondent has voluntarily waived his right to counsel and his right to an administrative hearing.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

From the Findings of Fact contained herein, the Commissioner concludes as follows:

6. The Commissioner may revoke a producer's license for any one (1) or more of the following causes: providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in the license application; having an insurance producer license or its equivalent denied, suspended, or revoked in any other state, province, district, or territory; and using fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness, lack of good personal or business reputation, or financial irresponsibility. Ark. Code Ann. § 23-65-512(a).

7. Respondent failed to disclose his guilty plea to the two charges against him, one a felony and one a misdemeanor, within thirty (30) days as required by Arkansas Code 23-64-517(b)(1).


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:
