ORDER

On this day, the matter of Marquez Miller (“Respondent”) came before Jay Bradford, Arkansas Insurance Commissioner (“Commissioner”). The Arkansas Insurance Department (“Department”) is represented by Ava Franks, Associate Counsel, in this matter. From the facts and law before the Commissioner, he finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On or about September 27, 2013, Respondent submitted to the Arkansas Insurance Department an Application for Arkansas Individual Resident Insurance Producer Limited Lines License (“application”).
2. Respondent disclosed criminal convictions from 1992 and 1993 on his application.
3. Respondent appealed the decision to deny his license application and, after proper notice, a hearing took place on Wednesday, November 6, 2013 at 10:00 am at the Department.
4. Respondent stated under oath that he served twelve (12) years of a thirty (30) year sentence.

5. Respondent has held four (4) steady jobs since his release, with no incidents. These jobs include door-to-door sales required trust, responsibility, and accountability.

6. Since conviction, Respondent has obtained a bachelors and masters degree and is anticipates to complete a second masters degree in 2014.

7. Since release, Respondent mentors youth through the O.K. Program, and was featured in the High Profile section of the Arkansas Democrat Gazette, June 24, 2012.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

8. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter pursuant to Arkansas Code Annotated § 23-61-103.

9. The Commissioner may issue a producer's license pursuant to Arkansas Code § 23-64-506, and § 23-64-507.

RECOMMENDATION OF THE HEARING OFFICER

WHEREFORE, based upon the foregoing Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and other matters before him, the Hearing Officer recommends:

7. That the Respondent should be granted an Arkansas Individual Resident Insurance Producer Limited Lines License.


