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**REVOCATION ORDER**

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On this day, the matter of John W. Johnson (“Respondent”) comes before Jay Bradford, Arkansas Insurance Commissioner (“Commissioner”). The Arkansas Insurance Department (“Department”) is represented by Ava Franks, Associate Counsel, in this matter.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Respondent holds Arkansas Nonresident Producer License No. 423217.
2. Respondent has convictions on his criminal record, including but not limited to criminal convictions in 2000, 2005, 2011, and 2012, none of which were disclosed to the Department.
3. Respondent did not disclose the aforementioned matter to the Department within thirty (30) days, nor did he disclose the matter to the Department on his application.
4. On or about September 26, 2013, the Department mailed a written inquiry to Respondent.
5. Respondent failed to provide a written response within thirty (30) days.

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

From the Findings of Fact contained herein, the Commissioner concludes as follows:

6. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter pursuant to Arkansas Code §23-61-103.

7. Respondent failed to disclose the criminal convictions to the Department within thirty (30) days as required by Arkansas Code §23-64-517(b)(1).


8. Respondent provided materially untrue information on his license application, which is a ground for licensure revocation. Ark. Code Ann. §23-64-512(a)(1)

9. Respondent failed to provide a written response to the Department's written inquiry within thirty (30) days as required by Arkansas Code §23-64-512(a)(13).

**RECOMMENDATION OF THE HEARING OFFICER**

WHEREFORE, based upon the foregoing Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and other matters before him, the Hearing Officer recommends:

10. Respondent's Arkansas Nonresident Producer License No. 423217 should be revoked.
