ORDER

On this day, the matter of Michael Rush (“Respondent”) came before Jay Bradford, Arkansas Insurance Commissioner (“Commissioner”). The Arkansas Insurance Department (“Department”) is represented by Ava Franks, Associate Counsel, in this matter. From the facts and law before the Commissioner, he finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On or about February 5, 2014, Respondent submitted to the Arkansas Insurance Department an Application for Arkansas Individual Resident Insurance Producer License (“application”).
2. Respondent disclosed in the affirmative to question 39.1, regarding criminal history, and provided a statement and documentation with his application.
3. On April 16, 2014, a hearing took place to determine whether Respondent should receive permission to sit for the Arkansas Insurance Producer’s Examination.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW


4. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter pursuant to Arkansas Code Annotated § 23-61-103.

5. The Commissioner may issue a license if an applicant is found to be of good personal, business reputation, financially responsible, and trustworthy. Ark. Code §23-64-506(c).

RECOMMENDATION OF THE HEARING OFFICER

WHEREFORE, based upon the foregoing Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and other matters before him, the Hearing Officer recommends:

6. Respondent should be allowed to sit for the Arkansas Insurance Producer's Examination.
