2. On or about June 18, 2014, A.I.D. Order No. 2014-146 was issued.


CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

3. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter pursuant to Arkansas Code §23-61-103.
4. An Appeal may be held to affirm, modify, or vacate an order. Ark. Code Ann. §23-61-103(f)(2).
5. An informal disposition of a proceeding or allegations that give rise to a proceeding by stipulation, settlement, consent or default in lieu of a formal or informal hearing on the allegations are permissible. Ark. Code Ann. §23-61-103(f)(7).
