REINSTATEMENT ORDER

On this day, the matter of Paul A. Shortnacy (“Respondent”) came before Jay Bradford, Arkansas Insurance Commissioner (“Commissioner”). The Department was represented by Amanda Capps Rose.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent holds Arkansas Resident Producer License No. 155872 and resides in Little Rock, Arkansas. Respondent’s producer license was previously suspended pursuant to A.I.D. Order No. 2012-548.
2. Respondent has entered into an Installment Agreement for Unpaid Child Support, and is current on payments under that agreement, and his license should, therefore, be reinstated. Reinstatement of the Respondent’s license is contingent upon remaining current under the Installment Agreement for Unpaid Child Support dated July 3, 2012.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW


3. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 23-61-103.
4. Pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 9-14-239, the Respondent’s Arkansas Resident

Producer License No. 155872 should be reinstated based upon the Installment Agreement between the Respondent and the Office of Child Support Enforcement dated July 3, 2012. The reinstatement of the Respondent's producer license is contingent upon his continued compliance with the Installment Agreement.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

5. Respondent's Arkansas Resident Producer License No. 155872 is hereby REINSTATED and any previous suspension of the license is lifted.
6. This Reinstatement Order shall supersede A.I.D. Order No. 2012-584.
