ORDER

On this day, the matter of Aneka Lyn Gillyard (“Respondent”) came before Jay Bradford, Arkansas Insurance Commissioner (“Commissioner”). The Arkansas Insurance Department (“Department”) was represented by Amanda Capps Rose, Associate Counsel, in this matter. From the facts and law before the Commissioner, he finds and concludes as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent holds Arkansas Nonresident Producer License Number 387733, which was suspended by A.I.D. Order No. 2012-329 due to the inactive status of the Respondent’s home state resident producer license.
2. Respondent has completed the License Surrender Form available on the Department’s website and submitted the form to the License Division of the Department.
3. Respondent has requested that she be allowed to freely and voluntarily surrender her Arkansas Nonresident Producer License.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

From the Findings of Fact contained herein, the Commissioner concludes as follows:


4. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 23-61-103.

5. Respondent has the right to voluntarily surrender her Arkansas Nonresident Producer License.

IT IS THEREFORE AGREED AND ORDERED:

In consideration of the above findings and conclusions, it is agreed that Respondent's Arkansas Nonresident Producer License Number 387733 is voluntarily surrendered and will be placed in inactive status effective as of the date of this order.
