REINSTATEMENT ORDER

On this day, the matter of Patrick S. Prince (“Respondent”) came before Jay Bradford, Arkansas Insurance Commissioner (“Commissioner”). The Arkansas Insurance Department (“Department”) was represented by Amanda Capps Rose, Associate Counsel, in this matter. From the facts and law before the Commissioner, he finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent holds Arkansas Resident Producer License No. 24948 and resides in Sherwood, Arkansas. Respondent’s Arkansas Resident Producer License was suspended pursuant to A.I.D. Order No. 2013-068 on July 17, 2013.
2. Pursuant to A.I.D. Order No. 2013-085, the Respondent’s producer license has remained suspended and placed in probationary status.
3. Respondent has fulfilled the requirements set forth in A.I.D. Order No. 2013-085 to the Commissioner’s satisfaction and his license should, therefore, be reinstated. Reinstatement of the Respondent’s license is contingent upon remaining current under the Installment Agreement for Unpaid Child Support entered into between the Respondent and the Arkansas Office of Child Support Enforcement.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

4. Pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 9-14-239, the Respondent's Arkansas Resident Producer License No. 24948 should be reinstated based upon information received from the Office of Child Support Enforcement.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

5. Respondent's Arkansas Resident Producer License No. 24948 is hereby REINSTATED and any previous suspension of the license is hereby lifted.

6. Respondent's Arkansas Resident Producer License shall remain in probationary status until September 4, 2014.

7. This Reinstatement Order shall replace A.I.D. Order No. 2013-085.
