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CONSENT REVOCATION ORDER

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On this day, Alan McClain, Arkansas Insurance Commissioner (“Commissioner”), and Meghan Hayes, (“Respondent”) agree to enter into this Consent Revocation Order for the reasons stated below. The Respondent neither admits nor denies any of the Findings of Fact or the Conclusions of Law below.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent, Meghan Hayes, is a licensed resident insurance producer in Malvern, Arkansas, and holds an Arkansas Resident Insurance Producer License, National Producer Number 17542731.
2. In 2020, Respondent submitted life insurance policy applications for several persons without their knowledge or consent. Respondent did this for purposes of pecuniary gain.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

From the Findings of Fact contained herein, the Commissioner concludes as follows:

1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the parties and subject matter pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. §§ 23-61-103, *et seq.*, and 23-64-501, *et seq.*

2. Respondent's actions are a violation of Ark. Code Ann. § 23-64-512(a)(10): Forging another's name to an application for insurance or to any document related to an insurance transaction.

3. Considering the Commissioner's Conclusions of Law, the Respondent agrees to a revocation of her producer license by the Department.

4. Respondent expressly waives all further procedural steps, and expressly waives all rights to seek judicial review of or to otherwise challenge or contest the validity of this Consent Order.

**THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED AND AGREED that:**

1. All licenses issued by the Department to Respondent Meghan Hayes are hereby revoked.

2. Respondent shall not directly sell, solicit, or negotiate any class or line of insurance in the State of Arkansas during the period of this revocation. Nothing within this paragraph or order shall prevent Respondent from engaging in activities within the insurance industry which do not require licensure.

3. Following the expiration of three (3) years from the date of this order, the Respondent may apply to reinstate her license in accordance with the provisions of Ark. Code Ann. § 23-64-217(b).
