CONSENT ORDER

On this day, Alan McClain, Arkansas Insurance Commissioner ("Commissioner"), and John Sivels, ("Respondent") agree to enter into this Consent Order for the reasons stated below. The Respondent neither admits nor denies any of the Findings of Fact or the Conclusions of Law below.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Respondent, John Sivels, holds an Arkansas Non-Resident Insurance Producer License, National Producer Number 8274016, and is a resident of Illinois.
- 2. In 2021, Respondent used insurance customers' personally identifiable information including banking information to fraudulently pay for personal expenses.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

From the Findings of Fact contained herein, the Commissioner concludes as follows:

1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the parties and subject matter pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. §§ 23-61-103 et seq., and 23-64-501 et seq.

- 2. Respondent's actions as described in the Findings of Fact above violate Ark. Code Ann. § 23-64-512(a)(8) of the Producer Licensing Model Act which forbids an insurance producer from "[u]sing fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices."
- 3. Considering the Commissioner's Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Respondent agrees to his producer license being revoked.
- 4. Respondent expressly waives all further procedural steps, and expressly waives all rights to seek judicial review of or to otherwise challenge or contest the validity of this Consent Order.

THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED AND AGREED that:

All insurance producer licenses issued by the Arkansas Insurance Department to Respondent John Sivels, NPN 8274016 are hereby revoked.
